WATERFORD POINT MAY 17, 2006 BOARD MEETING

Board members present were Stan Mikulski, Vincent Catania, Jan Van Schaik, Marge Kilroy, Ron Miller and Ernie Smith. There were 19 unit owners present.

After an open session for questions and discussion, the meeting was called to order. Jan Van Schaik read the minutes of the April 18, 2006 meeting. Marge Kilroy made a motion to accept the minutes as corrected. Ron Miller seconded the motion and it was so passed.

ANI Site Plan

Stan asked that we consider the ANI proposal for wireless towers on the roof. Vincent Catania made a motion to go ahead with the contract if all checks are satisfactory. The motion was seconded by Marge Kilroy and so passed.

Minutes of Dock Meeting – April 25, 2006

Jan Van Schaik read the minutes from the April 25, 2006 Boat Dock Meeting. Marge Kilroy made a motion to approve the minutes as read. Ron Miller seconded the motion and it was so passed.

\$300 Dock Fee

Stan stated that we would like to charge \$300 for dock fees to help defray some of the cost of the proposed new docks. Our attorney reviewed the documents and said it would be fair.

All dock renters will get letter with the proposal of the project. If the project is not approved the money goes back. If they move from the building the money goes back. If people refuse to pay the \$300 they will be removed from the list. We should gain about 15-20 docks with the new plan. Ron Miller made a motion we approve the fee. Ernie Smith seconded the motion and it was so passed.

Triangle Out Front - For police cars only 7:00 p.m. to 7:a.m. - Sunday all day

No more covered cars will be allowed in guest spots. Copies of revised Rules and Regulation are being mailed to all unit owners this week. That covers all these issues. Ron Miller stated the interview committee tells all new owners at their interview, to report any unusual happenings to the board.
